1-New York State Department of finance as well as The federal Cisa agency Require that the supply chain for the supplier be reviewed for incident management and due diligence and other regulatory requirements Such as BCp/Dr. If Vendor a signs a contract with vendor b then vendor a has to be concerned about vendor b and other vendors or suppliers who vendor b deals with to provide the services to Vendor a.

2-The location of the supplier data and Who has access to the data as well as GDPROCC PA or other privacy requirements are relevant. It's the domino effect of signing a contract with a vendor and the concern about the suppliers controls to meet the service that is being requested.
