The Bonds are expected to require a property tax levy for 30 years. <p>WASHOE COUNTY QUESTION NO. 1</p> <p>PARK, OPEN SPACE AND LIBRARY BOND QUESTION</p> <p>Shall Washoe County be authorized to issue up to \$38,300,000 of general obligation bonds for the purpose of acquiring, improving and equipping parks, trails, open space and library facilities located on park lands? \$11.8 million of the Bonds will be used for open space projects, \$2.13 million will be used for trail projects, \$14.37 million will be used for park projects and \$10 million will be used for library projects. The Bonds are expected to require a property tax levy for 30 years.
