The National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) of the Department of Commerce of the United States of America and the Agency for Standards and Technology of the Republic of Korea (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties"),


In accordance with the provisions of Article 7 of the Project Annex, and

In view of the continuing need for cooperation, have agreed to this Agreement to amend and extend (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") as follows:

1. In Article 2.B. the duration of the Phase 2 should be extended from 12 months to 18 months.
2. In Article 2.C. the duration of Phase 3 should be extended from 6 months to 12 months.
3. Provisions of the existing Project Annex, unless mentioned otherwise in this Agreement shall remain unchanged.
