NIST response to date

The NIST Director is:

- Planning a NIST safety leadership summit
- Developing a culture of safety accountability
 - Clear roles and responsibilities
 - The authority to carry out those roles and responsibilities
 - Clear expectations
 - Data to measure success

Safety Culture Maturity Model

- Level 1: Compliance
 - Existence of system, degree of compliance
- Level 2: Improvement
 - Effectiveness of system globally
- Level 3: Learning
 - Effectiveness of system locally
- Safety performance metrics – function of maturity
 - Mix of Level 1, Level 2, and Level 3

Metrics

- Key to robust safety program

NIST response to date

NIST is:

- Tracking OSHA-recordable incidents (TRC rate, DART rate)
- Identifying leading performance indicators (LPIs) that
 - Tie to where NIST is today
 - Will evolve as NIST's safety culture matures

Candidate areas for LPIs

- Safety climate / culture
- Management observations
- Training
- Hazard reviews
- Emergency planning
- Safety program development
- Assessments
- Inspections
- Incident reporting and investigation
- Safety service delivery

NIST assessment framework

- Assessment tier
 - Tier 1: Self assessment
 - Tier 2: OSHE assessment
 - Tier 3: Third-party assessment
- Assessment type
 - High-level program assessment, documentation assessment, full assessment
- Assessment scope
 - Safety scope, physical scope, organizational scope, temporal scope, coverage scope
- Assessments – function of maturity
 - Mix of tiers, types, and scopes

Establish an Audit mechanism

BRCII Finding

Third-party assessments

- Key to safety assurance program

NIST response to date

The CSO is identifying possible third-party mechanisms, including:

- DOE national laboratories
- Independent contractors
- Reciprocal relationships with other organizations (e.g., they assess us in Area A, we assess them in Area B)
