Consensus Standards

The TGDC recognizes the timeframes established in HAVA as necessary to ensure a prompt

response to the nation's voting system issues, which it was written to address. The TGDC further

recognizes that a robust voluntary consensus standards system exists in this country and should

be relied on, to the greatest extent possible, to facilitate the long-term development and regular

maintenance of voluntary voting system guidelines and standards.

Moreover, the TGDC encourages the EAC to rely not only on NIST's recognized expertise, but

also on the US voluntary consensus standards and conformity assessment systems, as

exemplified by programs and standards which comply with the requirements set-forth in OMB

Circular A119, as part of the EAC's long-term systemic approach to addressing the nation's

continuing need for up-to-date, voluntary voting system guidelines and standards.
