




- Brookville's definition is:


CoGeneration™: A process where power is generated by two or more sources simultaneously or individually to achieve maximum efficiency and minimum emissions.

Inherent Properties:

Low Emission Multi-engine Road/Switcher Locomotive



- Allows any or all of the 3 engines to feed the power grid.
- Engines are only operated as needed then shut down for zero emissions.
- Each traction motor is individually controlled for highest adhesion.
- Design allows for future product offerings


