- **Key Results**

- **Much of the VSS is valid and can be retained in the VVSG, either as is or rewritten to be more precise**
- **Most of the current functional and hardware requirements can stay largely intact:**
 - **some need to be made more precise and testable**
 - **others need to be updated to correspond to current technology**
- **The principal areas that require more major changes are:**
 - **accessibility and usability**
 - **security**
 - **software design and coding standards**
 - **configuration management**
 - **quality assurance**

- **The tables still contain some open questions**
- **There are still some uncompleted rewrites**
- **The analysis is a starting point for the development of the VVSG version 2**
