



LEGAL RESOURCE COMMITTEE MISSION

- The legal ramifications of standards.
- Meaningful use of forensic science standards by the legal system.







- Is the subject of the standard or guideline a new or novel technique?
 - A novel application of an older technique or method?

- Are there any adverse appellate court rulings on the admissibility of the technique?
 - If so, does the standard address the concerns identified in the court opinion(s)?
 - How?

Does the standard address the documentation and preservation of underlying materials and data?

Does the standard require any documentation of the case information the examiner was exposed to before or during the analysis?







- Are the directives of the standard specific and clear as to what they require or recommend?
- Are the technical terms used in the standard defined within the document?
 - If not, does the standard or guideline refer the reader to definitions published elsewhere?

Does existing research or data support the standard? If so, where can these be found?

To what extent and how has the technique been validated?





Are the error rates associated with the technique, when applied as prescribed or recommended, estimated? If so, how? If not, why not?

Is the uncertainty associated with measurements obtained by using a technique as prescribed or recommended in the standard estimated? If so, how? If not, why not?



Is something bad about to happen?

Focus on electronic communication.


