ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION

During the Enter-on-Duty orientation process, you MUST present **TWO** acceptable forms of identification. One ID must be any of the items from the list of PRIMARY FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION. The other ID must be from the list of SECONDARY FORM OF IDENTIFICATION.

- a) U.S. Driver's license
- b) Original or certified copy of a birth certificate
