
Executive Orders that could impact NIST

- Presidential Memorandum Regarding the Hiring Freeze January 23
 - Establishes a 90 day freeze on hiring by non-national or public security federal agencies
 - does not affect anyone with start date before Feb 22, other exceptions reviewed on case-by-case basis
- Presidential Memorandum Regarding Construction of American Pipelines – January 24
 - Requires Secretary of Commerce to develop a plan under which all US pipelines use materials and equipment produced in the US
- Presidential Memorandum Streamlining Permitting and Reducing Regulatory Burdens for Domestic Manufacturing – January 24
 - Directs Secretary of Commerce to coordinate plan for streamlining permitting and reducing regulatory burdens affecting domestic manufacturers




Balance in the Senate
