

Checklist for the NIST Summer Institute

- To be provided by the "applicant", which is the school district or accredited private education institution applying for the grant:

 - ✓ Additional:
 - (1) **Project Narrative.** This is a word-processed document, not to exceed five (5) pages, written by the applicant; it must contain the following information.
 - a. Description of the applicant's education programs that make it eligible to submit a NIST Summer Institute Program application, specifically, offering science classes at grade levels six (6), seven (7), and/or eight (8) (often termed middle school), including a description of its course offerings in general science fields, such as earth science, physical science, chemistry, physics, and/or biology.
 - b. Summary list of the teacher(s) being nominated and certification that:
 - Certify that each nominated teacher will have teaching responsibilities in general science fields at grade levels six (6), seven (7), and/or eight (8) (often termed middle school) in the 2019-2020 school year. (Applicants must certify to the best current knowledge/plans of the public-school district or accredited private educational institution in the U.S. or its territories at the time of application submission.);
 - Each nominated teacher is a U.S. citizen or permanent U.S. resident; and
 - If applicable, that the nominated teacher is from a "high-need school" as defined in 20 U.S.C. § 1021(11).
 - (2) A completed and signed NIST-1103, Teacher Application for the NIST Summer Institute for Middle School Science Teachers (NIST Summer Institute) or the NIST Research Experience for Teachers (NIST RET), for each teacher (NOTE: The information provided by each teacher should NOT be sent separately and must be included with the Applicant's application.)
- ♣ To be provided by each teacher:
 - ✓ A completed and signed NIST-1103, Teacher Application for the NIST Summer Institute for Middle School Science Teachers (NIST Summer Institute). NOTE: The information provided by each teacher should NOT be sent separately and must be included with the school district's or accredited private education institution's (the "Applicant's") grant application. NIST-1103's sent separately will not be accepted for consideration.



Hints for filling out the grant forms for the NIST Summer Institute

- 4. We don't use this field, however, feel free to put in your own Applicant identifier that you would like to use for your records.
