



Quick Facts About Maryland CTE

 Nearly half (50%) of all grade 10-12 high school students enroll in a CTE course (112,114)

• 21% of the class of 2012 completed a CTE Program of Study (12,527)


 54% of the CTE Graduates are "Dual Completers" – both College & Career Ready
