

Dr. Dan Neumann - Leader, Neutron Condensed Matter Science Group, NIST Center for Neutron Research

Dan Neumann is the leader of the Neutron Condensed Matter Science Group at the NIST Center for Neutron Research, a position he has held since 2005. The Group is responsible for advancing materials development and characterization in the US through neutron scattering. This is accomplished by assisting the scientific community with neutron measurements at NIST and by developing new neutron measurement methods and

instrumentation. Dan has served on international advisory and review committees at more than a dozen neutron facilities world-wide including the European Spallation Source, a \$2B facility currently under construction in Lund, Sweden. Dan came to NIST after completing his Ph.D. in physics at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign in 1987. He is a Fellow of the Neutron Scattering Society of America and the American Physical Society.
