

2017 DOC Financial Management Conference Update

Overview

- ☐ The Digital Accountability and Transparency Act (DATA Act), 31 U.S.C. § 6101 note, was enacted on May 9, 2014.
- ☐ The act amended the Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act of 2006 (FFATA) and required the standardization of certain financial data elements related to federal spending across government agencies.
- □ OMB and Treasury were required to publish this data by May 2017 on USAspending.gov, or its successor site.
- ☐ In addition to Procurement and Financial Assistance data, the DATA Act includes additional financial reporting at an Object Class and Program Activity level.
- ☐ The OMB/Treasury Team finalized the DATA Act Information Model Schema (DAIMS) v1.0 on April 29, 2016

- Designed, developed, and tested DOC DATA Act Broker design to meet DATA Act requirements to produce
 Treasury Files and received warning messages from Treasury DATA Act Broker
- Developed and implemented data transfer SFTP process with Bureaus
- Coordinated Program Activity and Object Class crosswalk maintenance value incorporation into DOC Broker
- Coordinated with Grants and Acquisition communities
- Coordinated with Financial Reporting communities
- Developed/performed DOC DATA Act Certification process
- Submitted and certified FY17 Q2 consolidated files in the Treasury Broker 4/28
- Data published on USASpending Beta site (https://beta.usaspending.gov/#/) 5/3 as unofficial data; on 5/9 banner was switched to:

- Financial info associated with Awards/Grants validated against financial system not previously available
- Award data previously available through FPDS-NG
- Grant data previously available through USASpending
- System for Award Management (SAM) and Subcontracting data
- Linkage of the above

- Participate in recurring sessions with Treasury DATA Act PMO to understand potential updates for Q3 submission







USASpending BETA - DATA Act Screen Shot Available Filters








USASpending BETA - DATA Act Screen ShotFederal Account Summary View




USASpending BETA - DATA Act Screen Shot Object Class View




USASpending BETA - DATA Act Screen Shot Program Activity View

Spending by Geography




