Dr. Karen Hardy is Director for Risk Management and Deputy Chief Risk Officer at the U.S. Department of Commerce.

Dr. Hardy served as a senior advisor on risk management policy to the Controller of the United States while on special assignment to the White House - Office of Management and Budget (OMB), within the Executive Office of the President and served as the principle author of Section 270, Part 6 of OMB Circular A-11. She also authored updates to the revised OMB Circular No. A-123, *Management's Responsibility for Enterprise Risk Management and Internal Control.* She is the first Federal employee to be selected to serve as a member of the COSO Advisory Council for ERM.

Prior to her federal career, she worked for Citicorp where she managed the operations of four regional branches.

Dr. Hardy is a founder of the Association for Federal Enterprise Risk Management and a former Board Vice President. She is the recipient of two Bronze Medal Awards for superior performance from the Department of Commerce.

Dr. Hardy received her bachelor's from Hampton University; MBA from Strayer University; and Doctor of Education (Ed.D.) degree in organizational leadership and human resource development from Nova Southeastern University.
