- Posters may be from:
 - Economic Development Agencies

 - o Industry
- Exhibit display is from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. Exhibit must be staffed from 12:00 to 12:45 and it is advised to also staff the exhibit during breaks
- The poster session is designed to highlight energy technology capabilities and partnering opportunities.
- Posters should fall into one of the six following nanotechnology-related areas:
 - o Biofuels
 - Renewable Energy
 - o Nuclear Energy
 - o Major Investors/Users of Energy
 - Environmental Impact Mitigation
 - o Energy Conservation and Efficiency
- Posters should give sufficient details regarding the technical aspects of the technology, but should be general enough to be understood by a broad range of individuals, including non-technical audiences.

- Posters should be geared towards a business development audience and should highlight the commercial applications of the technology.
- Posters should be no larger than 2 feet by 3 feet to fit on an easel.
