



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
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# The Crisis is Defined by the Number of Deaths

Remarks by the President in Panel Discussion at the National Prescription Drug Abuse and Heroin Summit, March 29, 2016, Atlanta, Georgia

DR. GUPTA: Mr. President, I'm going to start with you. ...Why this particular topic for you, sir?

THE PRESIDENT: Because it's important, and <u>it's costing lives</u>, and it's devastating communities. ... My job is to promote the safety, the health, the prosperity of the American people. ...You mentioned the number 28,000. I's important to recognize that today we are seeing <u>more people killed because of opioid overdose than traffic accidents</u>.

CONCLUSIONS AND RELEVANCE Prescription of long-acting opioids for chronic noncancer pain, compared with anticonvulsants or cyclic antidepressants, was associated with a significantly increased risk of all-cause mortality, including deaths from causes other than overdose, with a modest absolute risk difference. These findings should be considered when evaluating harms and benefits of treatment.






