Tuition is \$625 (\$640.00 Other Federal Gov't) per Session and due no later than 6:00 pm on the first Wednesday of each session. A NON-REFUNDABLE deposit of \$100.00 is required for each two-week session at the time of registration. This deposit will be applied to your tuition the first week of the session. Activity fees are included in the tuition this year and covers field trip fees and transportation, arts and craft supplies, water fun and daily food costs.

No refunds or adjustments to fees or tuition will be made for absences due to vacation, illness, or any other circumstance or schedule changes. PLEASE NOTE, YOU will be responsible for a session's full tuition if you choose to vacate your session and there is no one on the waitlist to take over your space.

Registration Guidelines

NIST Summer Camp is offered to children and grandchildren of NIST employees/associates and children of Federal Government employees. Each session of Summer Camp is limited to 30 children.

Priority registration for currently enrolled NIST CCC children begins immediately with this notice and continues through close of business on January 12, 2018. Registration for NIST alumni, siblings, and all others NOT currently attending the NIST CCC will be begin at 7:30 a.m. on January 16, 2018 in the multipurpose room of NIST CCC. Registration on January 16, 2018 will be for all remaining available slots not selected by current students and continues until such time that all 30 spaces per session are filled. If NIST CCC is closed for any portion of the morning of January 16 due to inclement weather, registration will take place on the next full work day for NIST CCC thereafter. Registration must be done in person at the child care center and each person in line can only register one family. No registrations will be accepted via the mail. Spaces are filled in the order in which deposits are <u>PAID</u> on a first come, first served basis. Once all camp spaces are filled, additional names will be placed on a waitlist for possible future openings/cancellations.

The Staff

Our camp leaders are trained to work with children age five to ten and meet the MSDE Office of Child Care guidelines for Teacher- School- Age. Our experienced, trustworthy staff gets to know your child individually and therefore is able to offer regular feedback. A camp staff member is always available who is certified in CPR and First Aid

The Activities

Weekly Themes - Our camp offers fun and exciting activities revolving around weekly themes to include arts and crafts, games, photo journals, and indoor and outdoor play.

Off Site Trips - The entire group will be scheduled to travel to local theatres, parks, amusements, restaurants and/or animal attractions each week. Lower teacher to camper ratio helps to ensure safety yet offer opportunities to enjoy our culturally rich surroundings. Children will be transported in the NIST CCC 20 passenger bus with seat belts. Please note, due to field trip contract limitations and limited bus space we will only be able to accommodate one or two parent volunteers per trip. Volunteer space will be rotated to allow each camper the opportunity to experience a trip with his/her parent.

Swimming and Water Fun - We visit Gaithersburg's Bohrer Park for water fun each week.

<u>Food Options</u> - From packing their own field trip brown bags to Friday's special meals, the children are actively involved in planning and preparing some of their summer camp foods. The lunches are included in the tuition.

On Site Specials - Performers and/or NIST scientists are invited to entertain campers throughout the summer usually on Fridays.

Allergy Policy

When a child has a life threatening or serious allergy to peanuts, peanuts will be prohibited from use in that child's classroom or any area that the child uses during the day. All parents in camp will be notified in writing of the banning of peanuts. Families are expected to comply with this request. For all other food or substance allergies, the Center will work with the child's family to provide the safest possible environment, and customize a special health care plan in cooperation with the child's physician.

Priority registration for current NIST CCC enrollees begins January 8th and continues through January 12, 2018. Registration for NIST alumni, siblings, and all others NOT currently attending the NIST CCC will be begin at 7:30 a.m. on January 16, 2018 in the multipurpose room of Building 320, for all remaining slots and continue until such time that all spaces in each session are filled. Registration must be done in person at the child care center and each person in line can only register one family. No registrations will be accepted via the mail. Payment of these fees at this time allows the teachers to organize field trips and specials, purchase supplies for arts and craft activities, and have food items available on the first day of your child's camp experience.

Up-to-date emergency, health and enrollment forms of children not currently enrolled at NIST CCC will be forwarded to the parent for completion in May 2018. ALL forms are **due the Wednesday prior to the start** of the first camp session attended.
