It would be nice if there were a secure online method to vote. I usually receive a mail-in ballot, but mine mysteriously didn't arrive during the 2020 election. I had to make a special request for a new ballot and then deliver it to a specific drop off location to ensure it was counted. At a minimum, it would be nice if I didn't have to request a mail-in ballot and instead just received one. My disability is well-documented and I receive SSDI benefits. It would be helpful if all SSDI and/or SSI recipients were just sent ballots or a link to vote electronically. There are secure ID-proofing methods like ID.me the government uses for other purposes so I don't see why we can't make secure electronic voting an option available to all people.
