Ultimately, I rely on others to physically cast ballots with and for me. Now come states like Texas where I live that want to impose more requirements and even potential criminal penalties on assistants who I rely on, further limit or eliminate curbside voting, and expand requirements to vote by mail. For people with disabilities, just getting out of bed and going out into life is burdensome – adding more obstacles in order to exercise their constitutional right to vote will certainly result in lost voters, disenfranchised people with disabilities.
