OMB Memo M-17-22: Government Reform

- Provides guidance on prior orders
 - Jan 23 "Hiring Freeze" Presidential
 Memorandum
 - Mar 13 "Comprehensive Plan for Reorganizing the Executive Branch" Executive Order
- Instructs Agencies to develop reform plan
 - Outline and approach by June, final by September
 - Aligned with Strategic Plans developed concurrently
 - Implemented with FY19 budget
- Will be led at the Agency (Dept. of Commerce) level

Comprehensive Plan for Reforming the Federal Government and Reducing the Federal Civilian Workforce

Agencies directed to eliminate, restructure or merge programs based on factors like:

- Duplicative
- Non-Essential
- Federalism
- Cost-Benefit
- Efficiency and Effectiveness
- Customer Service



Security Prioritization Sprint

Charge

Produce a holistic prioritized list of security vulnerabilities and associated mitigations using a methodology similar to the NIST safety framework

"Speed is more important than accuracy"
- 30 days -



Security Sprint: Prioritized Actions

- Identify the optimal organizational fit for security
- Establish clear baseline security requirements and R2A2s for the NIST staff
- Exercise leadership and improve accountability and understanding
- Create ESC-like advisory group to engage OU leadership in the establishment of the NIST security program
- Establish and implement security standards for NIST spaces warranting enhanced security
- Establish clear NIST security program requirements and R2A2s beyond the baseline
- Expand security awareness training (on topics such as active shooter, workplace violence, general crime prevention measures, suspicious packages)

National Commission on Forensic Science

- Established in 2013, the National Commission on Forensic Science (NCFS) was jointly chaired by NIST and DOJ
- Second term of NCFS expired April 23
- Last meeting April 10-11, 2017
