

# Specifications Document Bandpass Filters NB687050-16-04476

#### **BACKGROUND**

The mission of the Quantum Electromagnetics Division (Div 687) is to provide industry, and its suppliers and customers, with comprehensive and technically advanced measurement capabilities and standards, as well as traceability to those standards. A NIST research program on "Advanced Metrology for Greenhouse Gas Monitoring" has major measurement challenges in the development and validation of Differential Absorption LIDAR (DIAL) system to monitor and quantify the 3D concentration profiles and flux of the greenhouse gases, CO<sub>2</sub> and CH<sub>4</sub>.

#### **PURPOSE**

Remote sensing measurements of the greenhouse gas, CO<sub>2</sub>, in the atmospheric window region at 1602.0 nm are needed to be performed during daytime hours. These measurements require detection of light scattering from aerosol particles in the open atmosphere or from distant scattering from surfaces over km ranges. In both cases, the light levels for detection are so small that photon counting detection is required. During daytime operation, the solar flux into our receiver is enough to swamp any backscatter signal we receive unless a narrow bandpass filter is used to screen out a large fraction of the solar radiation.

#### **DELIVERABLES**

The contractor shall deliver at a minimum of two (2), but Not to Exceed (NTE) six (6) bandpass filters. Theses filters must pass a narrow band of radiation with high efficiency (> 90%) centered near the wavelength of 1602.0 nm of the transmitting laser.

- 5. Out-of-band blocking optical density: 4
- 6. Filter size: 1.0 inch diameter and 0.25 inch thickness
- 7. Surface flatness: 1602 nm /10
- 8. Surface quality: 80/50 scratch dig
- 9. Material: UV grade fused silica
- 10. Number of filters needed: 2
- 11. Option to provide additional filters will be considered
