**REFERENCES:** identify 2 professional references **and** confirm that they are willing to submit strong letters of recommendation. Notify your references through the online system. Please note that your references can only submit their letters after you click Submit and until the 3rd of Feb at 11:59 PM ET. Note that your application will be rejected if either recommendation letter is missing.

- Identify the NIST research programs that are your 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> choices. The NCNR CHRNS SURF page lists examples of past projects that are typical of the "MML/NCNR Material Science" program. It is important to choose a program that best fits your interest.

Input contact details for 2 confirmed references. Then **SUBMIT your application ASAP** : make sure to give your references enough time to write & upload their letter. Check with your references that they received an email request to submit their letters via the online application system (no later than 3 days after the vacancy closes, or your application will be rejected).
