Colorado Unemployment



General Information

Unemployment insurance (UI) provides temporary and partial wage replacement to workers who have become unemployed through no fault of their own.

The first week you are eligible for UI benefits is an unpaid waiting week. You must meet all of the weekly eligibility requirements during this week to be credited for an unpaid waiting week.

- Must have earned at least \$2,500 during a <u>designated base period</u>.
- Must be physically able, available, and actively seeking work, unless you are "job attached"
- You will need a recent SF-50 or paystub and a SF-8 (see next page)
- You must apply online (Click here to apply)
