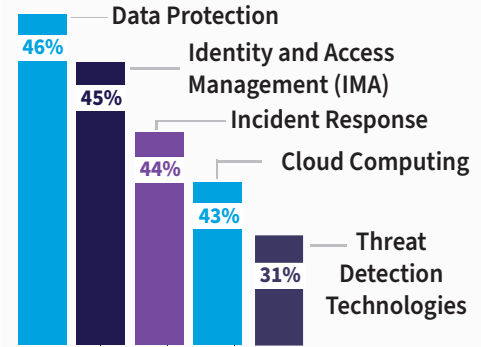

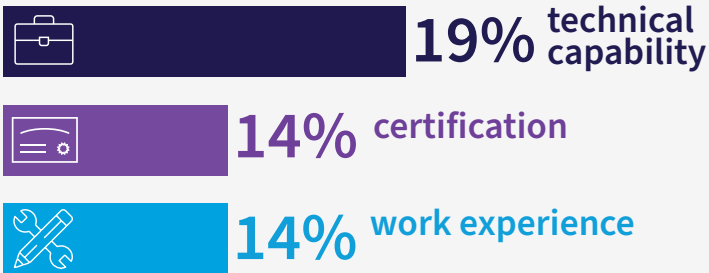

The top 3 ranking hiring qualifications: all regions

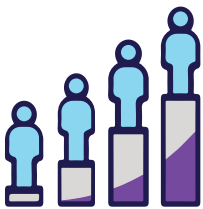
