- Parallel Threads (Many workers)
 - Tech Collects Latent Print
 - Examiner determines "of Value"
 - Examiner distills out the best image possible
 - Examiner identifies features
 - Examiner searches AFIS
 - LPE Looks at candidates
 - LPE Does Something





We Don't Know What We Don't Know

- No uniformity in data collection / terminology
- Do not follow a business model
- Many more Idents could be made
- AFIS not fully understood by users
- "We will give them what they ask for!"

- What is the optimum LT/TP searches?
- Is the UL file really useful?
- What about LT/LT searches?
- When to search other systems?
- Why are some examiners better?
- How do I acquire, train and retain LPE?

Business Success

- When you are doing something you are not doing something else!
- Emphasis those activities that will produce more identifications
- Idents processing uses rules of probability

Some Say Why, Some Why not

- Continue searching until a score is achieved?
- Search old cases on nights and weekends
- Integrate access to other systems via ULW
- Establish a partnership with other agencies

- If No, why not?

- More research in AFIS latent print processing
- Create national training and certification
- Develop a business model
- Make interoperability easier
- Move the political will to make it happen
