- 5. Send this application to NVLAP at <a href="mailto:nvlap@nist.gov">nvlap@nist.gov</a>. It is recommended that you retain a copy for your records. Do not pay accreditation fees at this time. Payment of fees will be handled through the NVLAP Interactive Web System (NIWS).
- NVLAP will email an acknowledgment to the AR, along with user account information, a link to the NIWS laboratory portal, and instructions for completing the remaining application steps through the NIWS.
