COUNTY MEASURE

26-48 THREE-YEAR INCOME TAX FOR SCHOOLS, HUMAN SERVICES, PUBLIC SAFETY

QUESTION: Should Multnomah County enact three-year 1.25% income tax for county schools, health and senior care and public safety?

SUMMARY: The state has cut funds for county schools, health and senior services and public safety. School districts have cut programs and instructional days. Senior citizens and low income families have lost necessary medications and housing assistance. Inmates have been released from jail early.

This measure enacts a three year 1.25% County income tax for services such as:

- Teachers, programs and instructional days for Multnomah County public schools, including Centennial, Corbett, David Douglas, Gresham-Barlow, Parkrose, Portland, Reynolds, Riverdale Districts;
- Prescription drug benefits for low income seniors;
Restore housing and independent living assistance for the elderly and disabled;
Health and mental health care for low income people;
- Reduce early release of inmates;
Offender drug and alcohol treatment.

For single filers, \$2,500 of taxable income is exempt. For joint filers, \$5,000 of taxable income is exempt. Taxable income is taxable income under Oregon law (after deductions) of Multnomah County residents.

This measure will raise an estimated \$135 million annually. Independent performance audits will be conducted. The only administrative costs are for tax collection.

**34-67 LOCAL OPTION TAX TO
RESTORE SOME STAFF AND
STUDENT PROGRAMS**

QUESTION: Shall District levy up to \$1.50 per \$1000 of assessed value annually for three years beginning 2003-2004 for operations? This Measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

SUMMARY: This Measure may be passed at an election with at least a 50 percent turnout.

The downturn in the economy has caused Legislature to reduce basic operating funds for all Oregon schools. The Beaverton School District is estimating a funding shortfall of \$30-35 million for 2003-04. Local option taxes would be used to restore some staff positions and student education programs. Without the additional revenue, the District will have to reduce staff and programs. This Measure authorizes Beaverton School District 48J, in Washington and Multnomah Counties, Oregon, a property tax in the amount of up to \$1000 of assessed value each year for five years.

An estimate of the total amount to be raised each fiscal year is:

2003-2004	\$17,890,000
2004-2005	\$19,860,000
2005-2006	\$21,850,000

The total amount of money to be raised by this Measure is estimated to be \$59,600,000.

The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the county assessors of Washington County and Multnomah County at the time of the estimate.

5-112 FIVE YEAR LOCAL OPTION TAX FOR DISTRICT OPERATIONS

QUESTION: Shall the District levy \$0.54 per \$1000 of assessed value each year for five years beginning 2003-2004 for operations? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

SUMMARY: This measure may be passed only at an election with at least fifty percent voter turnout.

This measure authorizes the Scappoose School District 1J to levy property tax in the amount of \$0.54 per \$1000 of assessed value each year for five years. The taxes would be used to help finance district operations and partially alleviate cuts to staffing and programs. The funds raised by this measure are estimated at \$500,000 per year. This estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of the estimate.

26-47 LUSTED WATER DISTRICT, MULTNOMAH COUNTY, GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND AUTHORIZATION

QUESTION: Shall Lusted Water District be authorized to issue general obligation bonds in an amount not exceeding \$480,000? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property ownership that is not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

SUMMARY: This measure may be passed only at an election with at least a 50 percent voter turnout. If approved, the bond funds would be used to remove the existing Barlow tank and construct and equip a new elevated water tank and to pay costs of issuance. The bonds will mature in 20 years or less.
