NIST Handbook 150-22, which presents the technical requirements and guidance for the accreditation of laboratories under the NVLAP Voting Systems Testing Laboratory Accreditation Program (LAP), has been revised.

NIST Handbook 150-22, NVLAP Voting System Testing, presents the technical requirements and guidance for the accreditation of laboratories under the NVLAP Voting System Testing LAP. The 2017 edition is based upon revisions to the Voluntary Voting System Guidelines (VVSG) Version 1.1, the U.S. Election Assistance Commission (EAC) Testing and Certification Program Manual Version 2.0, and the EAC Voting System Test Laboratory Program Manual Version 2.0, and supersedes and replaces the 2008 edition.
