How to Get Involved

For K12 Audiences

- Invite speakers to your school to present lectures and demonstrations about cybersecurity careers

- Partner with a science museum to present hands-on-exhibits about the field of cybersecurity
- Use one of NICE's downloadable resources as a classroom activity

For Adult Audiences

- Coordinate a lecture, workshop, or activity on careers in cybersecurity
- Set up and staff an exhibit table at a local office or community center to distribute resources
- Launch a social media campaign to spread the word
- Contact local radio or television stations to incorporate a career in cybersecurity segment
- Volunteer to assist or coach a cybersecurity competition team
