INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING

STRAIGHT TICKET VOTING.

To vote for every candidate of one party, connect or complete the arrow(s) ← opposite the name of the party for whom you wish to vote, like this: ←

SPLIT TICKET VOTING.

You can vote a straight party ballot and also connect or complete the arrow(s) ← for selected candidates from another party, like this: ← . This will credit all candidates from straight party ballot except for the selected candidates that you marked.

To vote for individual offices and non-partisan offices, connect or complete the arrow(s) ← to the right of your choice like this: ←

WRITE-IN VOTES.

To vote for a candidate not on this ballot write candidate's name on the line provided and connect or complete the arrow(s) ← to the right of the candidate's name like this: ←

For an affirmative vote upon any public measure, question, or to retain a Judge, connect or complete the arrow(s) after the word "YES" like this: ←

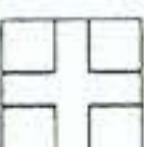
